

RE: Proposed Craig Park Bike Facility

Dear Ms. Blackwood:



It is our understanding that the proposed facility will provide a much needed skills course for beginners, intermediate, and advanced mountain bikers. To our knowledge, no other facility like this exists in Orange County. With our focus on finding a balance between recreational trail use and resource protection, we are increasingly aware that education is key to ensuring this balance is found. To this end, we support providing a safe, reliable and easy to access location for training and skills development that spans the ability spectrum. Encompassing all age groups and skill levels will help encourage proficiency, technique, and ridership among this user group.

Based on the tour with OC Parks staff and a subsequent meeting with the Safe Trails Coalition Core Team, we believe there is merit to the project in concept. We wanted to offer our initial support. Concurrently, we will await the environmental review and analysis of impacts, so we can more fully understand the resources, the impacts, and the potential mitigation needed. Most specifically, concerns have been raised about nesting bird species in the adjacent trees. When the environmental impact report is released, we will provide substantive input at that time and will re-evaluate our position again.
