Newport Beach City Councilwoman and bicycle safety advocate Leslie Daigle was hospitalized Thursday after a head-on crash with another cyclist in Irvine.

In an interview Friday from Hoag Hospital, Daigle said she suffered a C5 neck fracture, but was hoping to go home Sunday.

"I'm fully mobile, which is good," she said. "Everything is moving."

Daigle said the crash happened about 7:30 a.m. Thursday. She had participated in an early morning ride through Irvine, then headed by herself onto the Shady Canyon Trail ...
